Privacy Policy

At Texpile LLC, we take your privacy seriously and are committed to maintaining the security and confidentiality of your personal information. This privacy policy ("Policy") describes how Texpile LLC("Company," "we," and "our") processes, collects, uses and shares personal data when using this website, including all subdomains such as https://editor.texpile.com (collectively, the "Services"). We encourage you to read this Policy carefully to understand our practices regarding your personal data and how we will process data.

Purposes of Processing

What is personal data?

Within the context of this Policy, we collect various forms of information, encompassing what is commonly referred to as "personal data." As delineated in the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), the term "personal data" pertains to any information that, either individually or when amalgamated with other data under our purview, serves to uniquely identify you as an individual. Such data may encompass, but is not restricted to, particulars such as your name, postal address, email address, and telephone number.

Why do we need your personal data?

We process your personal data for the following purposes:

- Account Creation and Authentication: To create your account, authenticate your identity, and provide you with access to our services, we require your email, username, and password. You also have the option to sign in with Google, which will provide us with your email and associated information.
- **Service Provision**: To offer you personalized and secure document editing experience, including the ability to save and retrieve your documents.
- **Communication**: To send you important updates, notifications, and information related to your account and our services.

Collecting Your Personal Data

We collect information about you in the following ways: **Information You Give Us.** This includes:

- The personal data you provide when you register to use our website, including your username, email address, and password;
- The personal data provided by third-party authenticators such as "Sign in with Google";
- The personal data you provide when you report a problem with our website or when we provide you with customer support;
- The personal data you provide when you make a purchase through our website;
- The personal data you provide when you correspond with us by phone, email, or otherwise;

Information Automatically Collected.

We automatically log information that your browser provides to us when accessing the website. For example, when visiting our website, we log your computer or mobile device's operating system name and version, manufacturer and model, browser type, browser language, screen resolution, and IP address. This information is provided by your browser.

Cookies

What are cookies?

The collection of information through the employment of "cookies" is a practice that we may undertake. Cookies, in this context, represent diminutive data files that are housed within the hard drive of your computing apparatus or mobile device by a given website. Our usage encompasses two primary categories of cookies: session cookies, which have a transitory existence and expire upon the closure of your web browser, and persistent cookies, which endure on your computing apparatus or mobile device until you choose to remove them. These cookies are instrumental in providing you with an enhanced, individualized, and interactive experience during your interaction with our website.

Two Distinct Categories of Cookies

Our utilization of cookies comprises two distinct classifications:

- 1. **First Party Cookies**: These are directly dispensed by us to your computing apparatus or mobile device, serving the sole purpose of recognizing your computing apparatus or mobile device when you revisit our website.
- 2. **Third Party Cookies**: These are administered by service providers who operate on our website. Service providers may harness these cookies to identify your computing apparatus or mobile device not only on our website but also during its visits to other websites.

Cookies are instrumental in enhancing the functionality and personalization of your web experience, thereby facilitating an enriched user interaction with our website.

Cookies we use

Our website uses the following types of cookies for the purposes set out below:

Type of cookie	Purpose
Essential Cookies	These cookies are essential to provide you with services available through our website and to enable you to use some of its features. For example, they allow you to log in to secure areas of our website and help the content of the pages you request load quickly. Without these cookies, the services that you have asked for cannot be provided, and we only use these cookies to provide you with those services.
Functionality Cookies	These cookies allow our website to remember choices you make when you use our website, such as remembering your language preferences, remembering your login details and remembering the changes you make to other parts of our website which you can customize. The purpose of these cookies is to provide you with a more personal experience and to avoid you having to re-enter your preferences every time you visit our website.
Analytics and Performance Cookies	We may use Google Analytics, a service that uses its own cookies to help us understand how visitors use our website. These cookies collect aggregated data such as the number of visitors, the pages visited, and referring websites. They do not collect personal information like names, email addresses, or precise locations. We use this information to operate our website more efficiently and to monitor its performance. While we are not currently using Google Analytics, we may enable it in the future to help us improve our website's performance and user experience. Our website is hosted on Google's servers. - for analysis and study services; and
- as described in the "Sharing of your Personal Data" section below.

Sharing Your Personal Data

We may share your personal data as follows:

- Third Parties Designated by You. We may share your personal data with third parties where you have provided your consent to do so.
- Our Third Party Service Providers. We may share your personal data with our third party service providers who provide services such as data analysis,

payment processing, information technology and related infrastructure provision, customer service, email delivery, auditing and other similar services.

Our website may contain links to third party websites and features. This Policy does not cover the privacy practices of such third parties. These third parties have their own privacy policies and we do not accept any responsibility or liability for their websites, features or policies. Please read their privacy policies before you submit any data to them.

Your Documents and Privacy

When you use our document editor, the content of your documents is private and will not be shared with or viewed by anyone else without your explicit consent.

We may access your document content only in the following situations:

- When you request support: If you contact us for help with a specific document, we may need to access it to understand and resolve the issue.
- With your permission: We may ask for your permission to view your document content for other specific reasons, such as to investigate a bug report or to improve our services.

We may collect and analyze metadata associated with your documents. This metadata includes information such as document names, creation dates, modification dates, and file sizes. This helps us understand how our service is being used and improve its performance and features.

Retention

We will only retain your personal data as long reasonably required for you to use the website until you close your account/cancel your subscription unless a longer retention period is required or permitted by law (for example for regulatory purposes).

Your Rights
